

Museum of Oxford – Visitor Information (2026)

1. General Information

The Museum of Oxford (MOX) is located inside **Oxford Town Hall** in the city centre. The museum tells the story of Oxford and its people through historical objects, interactive displays, and exhibitions about the city's culture and development.

Visitors usually spend **about 1–2 hours** exploring the museum galleries and exhibitions.

Starting in **2026**, the museum introduced a small entrance fee.

Some groups (schools, carers, volunteers)	Free

When buying as combo ticket Visitors are saving £2 on adult and £1 on Student/Senior.
